- The wider and thicker belt creates a stable connection around your waist, releasing strains on your neck, shoulders, arms and hands
- Placement of the belt lowers the center of gravity to your hips or waist so you are able to stop your dog simply and quickly
- Core strengthening is obtained while you are in motion and by adjusting your body to direct your dog's movement
- Durable belt constructed to stand up to the elements



## Key Features of the Black Belt

- O-ring swivel design prevents tangles, and is structured to accommodate multiple leashes as well as pulls and jerks
- Discrete zippered pocket for phone, keys or bags
- Belt secures tightly with quick-release Velcro for a safe and easy fit
